"The Tale of Genji" is not only one of Japan's most important literary masterpieces, but it is universally recognized as one of the world's greatest romantic works. This remarkable prose narrative, one of the first literary works ever published in the world, was written by a young woman - Murasaki Shikibu circa 1000 A.D. A classic tale that revolves around the character of Hikaru Genji (the "Shining Prince"), the son of an emperor's favorite concubine, "The Tale of Genji" has inspired countless thousands of Japanese artists to illustrate scenes from its 54 chapters. Perhaps one of the most outstanding of these Genji illustrations is that of a member of the Edo School of Art (17th Century A.D.) which serves as the inspiration for this philatelic tribute.

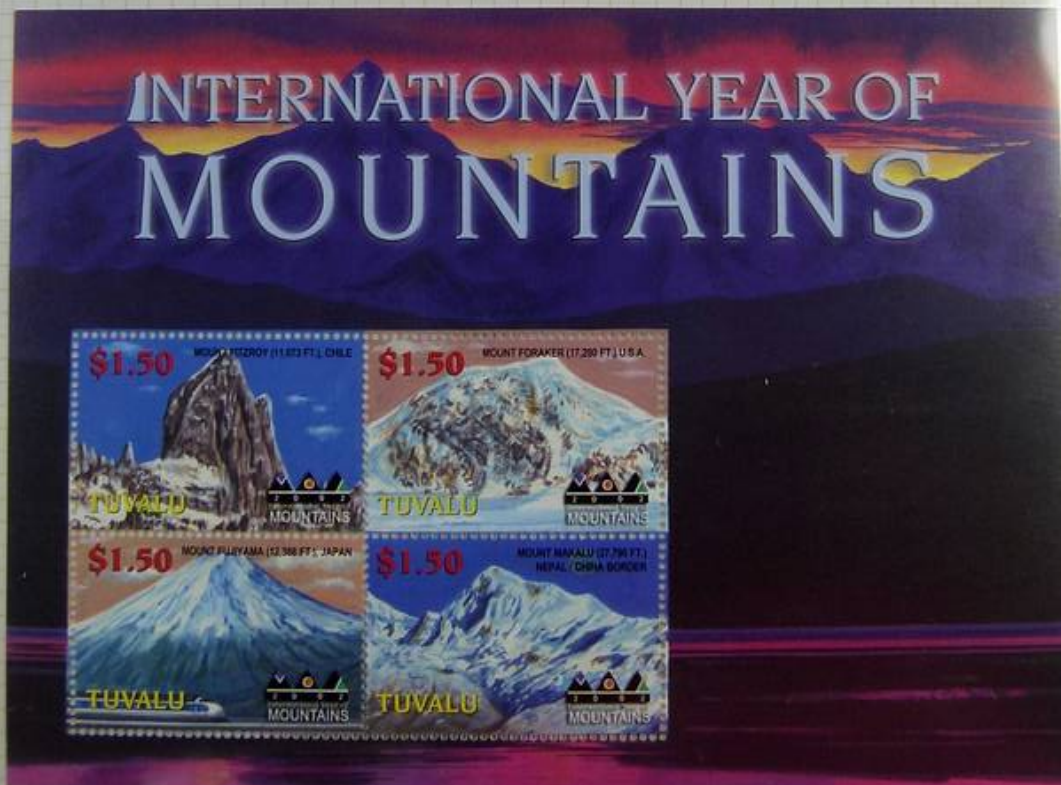

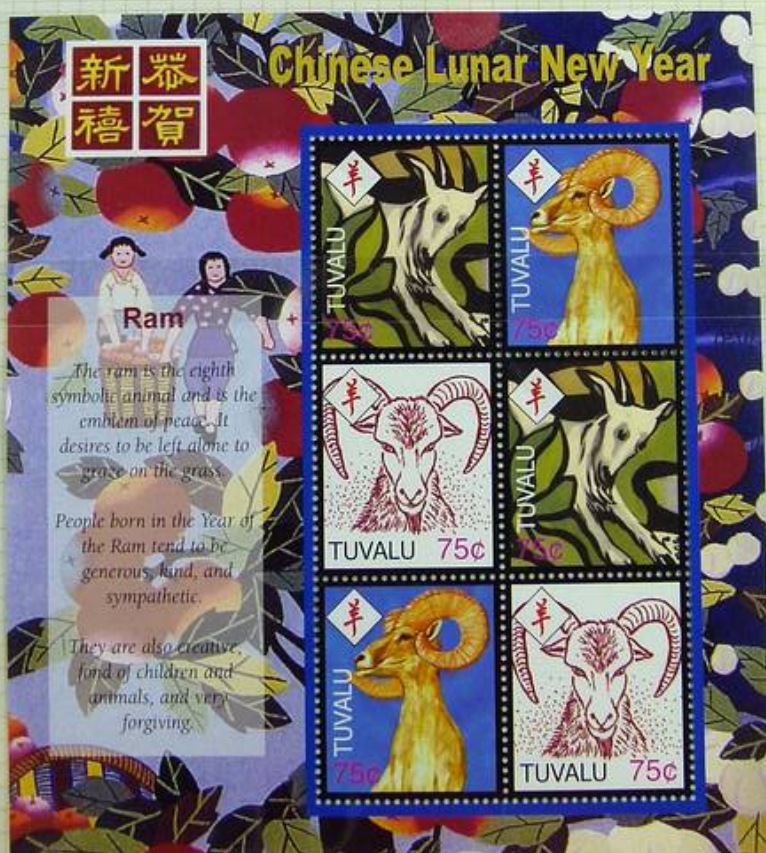

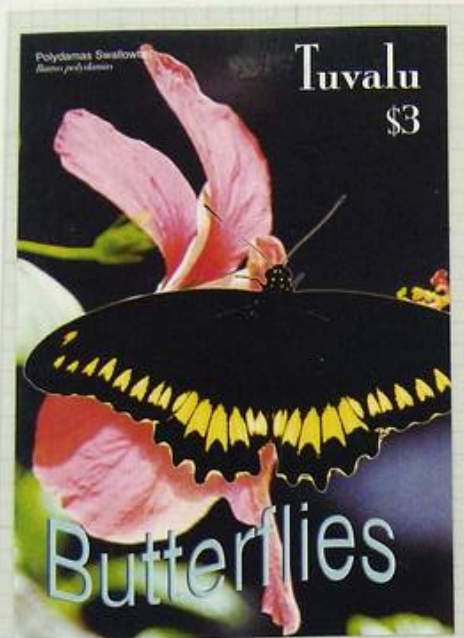


THE DECADE 1960-1970

The Fifties proved to be a decade of many milestones for the Tour which would celebrate its Fiftieth birthday in 1953. Perhaps one of the greatest stages ever run from Brive to Agen by the Swiss wonder Hugo Kobet, the eventual champion in 1951, drew superlative praises of his peers. Lucien Lazarides said "...Kobet must have a motor under his chest." The Tour at its half century mark was won in 1953 by Louison Bobet, who would go on to win in 1954 and 1955. Bobet was the dominant force of the decade and emerged as the French National Team's true leader.

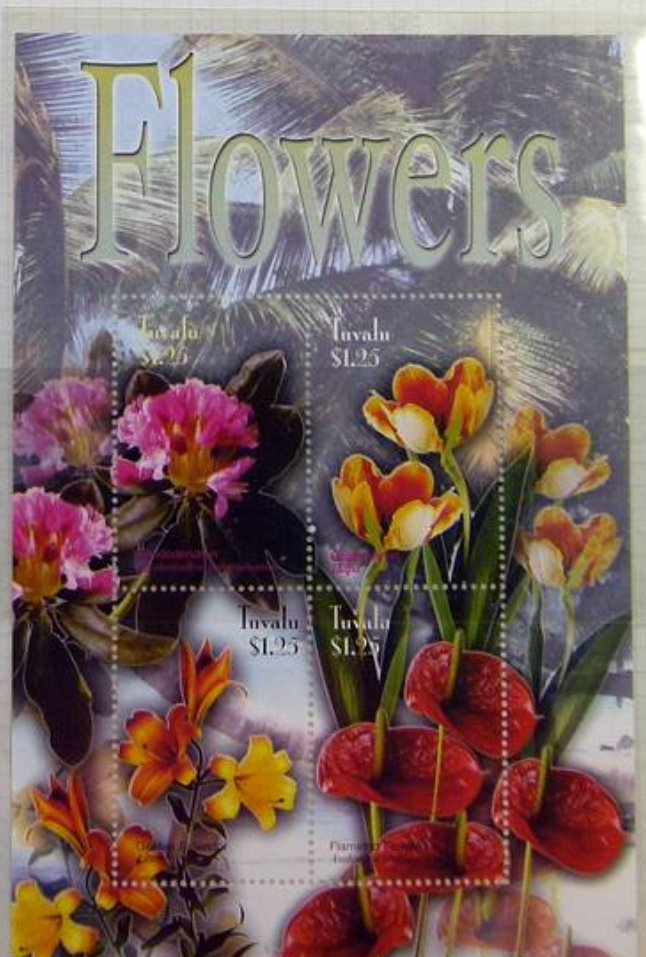
